Associates at the Milndavie Pottery

We have two categories of Associate, "Fully Catered" and "Self Catered".

To become an Associate of the Milndavie Pottery you must have an ongoing booking to use the pottery studio for at least 8 hours per week. The booking must be for a regular timetable each week.

Fully catered Associates pay £5 per hour (= £40 per week for 8 hours of bookings). Self catering Associates pay £4 per hour (= £32 per week for 8 hours of bookings). We prefer payment by standing order.

The Milndavie Pottery is a lovely building in Strathblane, which is a few miles from Milngavie. The bus stop is a couple of hundred metres from our doorstep and we have plenty of on-site parking.

If you are interested in becoming one of our Associates we would be very happy to discuss the idea with you. We currently have space for Associates during these times:

Whole day Tuesdays:
between 7.30am and 10pm

Short day Thursdays:
between 7.30am and 4pm

Half day Sundays:
between 7.30am and 1pm

Evening Sundays:
between 5pm and 10pm

Mornings Mon, Weds, Fri, Sat:
between 7.30am and 10.45am

What you will get

A key to let yourself in to the pottery. You will also be given your own personal burglar alarm log-in number.

Shared space within the studio at the time you have booked, includes:

- Working space for handbuilding and glazing
- At least 50% of booked time available on a wheel
- Access to our kiln
- Heated, light airy studio
- A permanent shelf of your own (80cm long) to store your own things.
- Unlimited access to all pottery equipment (except the wheels and kiln, see below)
- Modern bathroom (wheelchair accessible)
- Free wifi
- Kitchen facilities (sink, kettle, microwave)
- Tea and coffee and milk at no extra charge
- A tuck box to buy snacks and treats from (just crisps and chocolate)
- Lovely views of the campsie hills from the back of the pottery

Shared access to our wheels – two wheels shared by up to four associates, so four hours guaranteed on the wheel within each 8hr booking – this time must be booked as there will be a wheel timetable.

Fully-Catered Associates use our clay, glaze, and kiln (at least one shelf available in the kiln each week). Self-Catered Associates provide their own clay and pay an additional fee for use of the kiln.
